Transportation to UNC

- Bike: UNC is a silver-level Bicycle Friendly University
- Buses
 - Within Chapel Hill and Carrboro: free
 - Outside of this area: free with a GoPass
- Park and ride (drive to a parking lot, ride a bus to campus)
 - Lots in Chapel Hill: \$234 per year
 - Lots outside of Chapel Hill (in Durham, etc.): free
- On-campus parking: \$605 per year
- Point-to-Point transportation: free service for accessibility and for nighttime transit





Bull Durham & The Tobacco Industry



- Durham's production of tobacco and cigarettes boomed after the Civil War
- Tobacco brought trade, trains, and banking to the Triangle area
- The Duke family owned one of the largest tobacco businesses
- Bull logo comes from "Durham Mustard" containers from England
 - Now a mascot for the city and the minor league baseball team

Dr. Bartlett Leonidas Durham (1824-1859)


- Graduate of UPenn Medical School (allegedly)
- Purchased land between Prattsburg and Pinhook areas
- Donated land to the NC Railroad
 - They named the stop Durham's Station
 - Area around the stop grew into a collection of stores called Durhamville
- Went on to serve in the NC General Assembly
- Fueled by the post-Civil War tobacco boom, the city of Durham was incorporated in Dr. Durham's honor


